MOST IMPROVED PLAYER

The dealer who has seen, in each territory, the best improvement in sales volume in dollars from previous year to current year. There will be one for each territory.

ALPHONSE LEPAGE AWARD (STAFF FAVORITE)

Our staff will vote for their favorite dealer to work with, by territory, based on our corporate values, as well as the quality of information received, and partnership feel with the dealer.

GUY BONNEVILLE AWARD
